You may already be aware that we have been appointed by Broadland District Council to work with Acle Parish Council and other local groups (which have formed the Acle Village Team) to have a look at Acle and identify ways and means of helping to support and enhance the economy of the Village and its hinterland. We are currently undertaking extensive consultation with a range of stakeholders and research to help us understand how the Village is working and to identify areas that we can help to develop and support.

Vital to the way in which the Village and its hinterland function is the business community and therefore I would like to invite you to join us from **5pm until 7pm on Friday 2nd November at Acle Church Room, Norwich Road, Acle (adjacent to the Church and opposite Budgens)**. We would like to have an informal discussion with you and other businesses about ideas, issues, concerns, aspirations etc you may have for the Village and wider area. We hope to develop a strong working relationship with the businesses in and around Acle in the next few months and therefore hope that you can join us on the 2nd.
